Featuring the six unmarried daughters of Mr William Allamont of Allamont Hall. When their father dies unexpectedly, his will includes surprisingly generous dowries for the sisters, but only on condition that they marry in the proper order, the eldest first.

The Silver Linings Mysteries series

The sinking of the *Brig Minerva* results in many deaths, but for others, the future is suddenly brighter. But it's not always easy to leave the past behind...

- **Book 0: The Clerk:** the sinking of the Minerva offers a young man a new life (FREE prequel novella).
- Book 1: The Widow: the wife of the Minerva's captain is free from his cruelty
- **Book 2: The Lacemaker:** three sisters inherit a country cottage.
- Book 3: The Apothecary: a long-forgotten suitor returns, now a rich man, but is he all he seems?
- Book 4: The Painter: two children are left to the care of a reclusive man.
- **Book 5: The Orphan:** a wilful heiress is determined to choose a notorious rake as her guardian.
- Book 6: The Duke: the heir to the dukedom is reluctant to step into his dead brother's shoes.

The Strangers series

The small village of Great Maeswood is disrupted by the arrival of a succession of strangers who uncover the villagers' secrets, or bring their own secrets with them.

- Book 4: Stranger at the Manor: a destitute man comes looking for help from his cousin.
- Book 5: Stranger at the Cottage: an out-of-work governess tries to start a school in the village.
- Book 6: Stranger at the Hall: the newly discovered heir to the barony arrives to claim his inheritance.

The Mercer's House series

Following the fortunes of the Fletcher family, grown vastly wealthy in the north of England and now seeking to move up in the world by becoming landed gentry. Their goal is to marry the beauty of the family into the nobility, but they find it isn't quite as simple as they'd hoped to leave behind their roots in trade.

- Book 4: A Michaelmas Truce: the cross spinster and the even crosser bachelor.
- Book 5: An Autumn Courtship: the intellectual son and the flighty socialite.
- **Book 6: A Christmas Betrothal:** the beautiful daughter, the unhappy son and the lost lover.
- **Book 7: The Gentleman Farmer:** what happened afterwards (a novel-length sequel FREE for all readers no need to sign up for anything)
